



7-10 SWIMMING CARNIVAL – THURSDAY 8 NOVEMBER

Dear Parents and Students,

The 7-10 Swimming Carnival is to be held at the **Hobart Aquatic Centre** on **Thursday 8 November** from **9:00am until 2:45pm**. This is an important and compulsory day for all students.

- ❖ **Travel** – Students can make their own way to the carnival at the Hobart Aquatic Centre, or can arrive at school by 8:35am at the latest and catch a bus provided by the school. However, all students must return to the College for afternoon pastoral period and buses will be used as transport.
- ❖ For those students who are making their own way to the pool, they have been asked to arrive at the Pool between **8.30-8:40am** and report to their House area and Pastoral Teacher. Warm ups will begin at 9:00am through an announcement.
- ❖ **Students must wear their bathers to the carnival to save congestion in the change rooms at the beginning of the day.** Bathers may be two-piece but please within reason for a school event. College Bathers are also available at the Uniform Shop and are compulsory for students in the School Swimming Team.
- ❖ All students are to wear full PE uniform to and from the pool, and then can get dressed in their house colours whilst at the pool.
- ❖ **THE CANTEEN WILL BE UNAVAILABLE TO STUDENTS - YOU MUST BRING YOUR OWN LUNCH.** The Aquatic Centre tends to be very humid and dehydrating. Please bring plenty of water to drink.
- ❖ All students are to remain seated in their house areas unless they are in or preparing for an event.
- ❖ **Students who are not competing and would still like to get in and have a swim must bring their bathers as we have fun activities for them in the 25m pool.**
- ❖ **Non-Swimmers (students that don't intend to get wet) must have a note and give the note to their pastoral teacher.**
- ❖ We ask that parents refrain from taking photos at the carnival – we will have designated staff photographers on the day.
- ❖ **Parents are most welcome** to attend and any assistance that can be offered would be greatly appreciated. **If you are able to assist could please email kfarr@dominic.tas.edu.au.**
