### Expectations

- Full Dress Uniform must be worn to and from school. Should a student visit a public place, such as a library or shopping centre, on the way to or from school, the student is expected to wear Full Dress Uniform, including hat. Uniforms must be clean, pressed and in good repair, with shoes clean and polished.
- Full Dress Uniform must be worn to all College meetings, interviews, events, performances, concerts and exhibitions, whether in school hours or out of school hours, including weekends.
- It is expected that hair is neatly presented at all times when in uniform. Boys' hair must be cut in a conservative College cut and not be shorter than a number 3 clipper.

- All authorised Ormiston College Uniform items (with the exception of shoes) must be purchased from the Ormiston College Uniform Shop.
