Expectations

- Full Dress Uniform must be worn to and from school. Should a student visit a public place, such as a library or shopping centre, on the way to or from school, the student is expected to wear Full Dress Uniform, including hat. Uniforms must be clean, pressed and in good repair, with shoes clean and polished.
- Full Dress Uniform must be worn to all College meetings, interviews, events, performances, concerts and exhibitions, whether in school hours or out of school hours, including weekends.
- Blazers are worn in Term 2 and Term 3, and are required for formal functions.
- If a girl's ears are pierced, a single pair of sleepers or small plain studs may be worn.
- It is expected that hair is neatly presented at all times when in uniform. Girls' hair of at least shoulder length is to be neatly tied back in a conservative style, in a single plait or ponytail, finished with maroon ribbon or scrunchie and allow the dress hat to be worn.

- All authorised Ormiston College Uniform items (with the exception of shoes) must be purchased from the Ormiston College Uniform Shop.
